



PERTH ACADEMY UNIFORM POLICY 2014

In Perth Academy, we promote and encourage the wearing of full school uniform by all pupils. This leaflet will explain what is acceptable and what is not acceptable as part of our uniform policy and includes clear information for parents and carers.

Perth Academy School Uniform

- ▶ Plain white shirt
- ▶ Perth Academy tie
- ▶ Plain black v-necked jumper or cardigan (optional)
- ▶ Plain black trousers or skirt (skirts should be of an appropriate length)
- ▶ Plain black shoes
- ▶ Perth Academy blazer with school crest

Outerwear (coats, hats, etc.) may be worn in inclement weather. However, all of these should be removed when in the school building. (Lockers are available throughout the school).

The following items are **not** acceptable as school uniform:

- ▶ Jeans, skinny jeans, leggings and jeggings
- ▶ Combat trousers, tracksuits and jogging bottoms
- ▶ Branded clothing
- ▶ Shorts or hotpants
- ▶ Football colours
- ▶ Other items as agreed

School uniform has a number of benefits including:

- ▶ Encouraging a sense of belonging and pride in the school
- ▶ Enhancing the school image in the community
- ▶ Discouraging bullying which may arise from pupils not having certain items of clothing or footwear
- ▶ Improving security on school trips through easy identification of Perth Academy pupils
- ▶ Improving school security by easy identification of intruders
