# Pupils as active partners in improvement





## Feedback on Learning Experiences:

- Pupils want more library/ICT access
- More training for pupils how to cope with stress
- Teachers are too stressed
- Want a better school environment – heating, cleaning, state of classrooms
- Take away Home Room and give time to other subjects
- Study and social areas for pupils
- Some teachers could be more respectful towards pupils
- Teacher should be more supportive with children with difficulties
- More 1:1 conversations
- More support workers in classes



# School improvement suggestions for the 16/17 School Improvement Plan

- School ethos: better behaviour – improve respect
- Crack down on uniform
- Better wi-fi
